



RPBL BAT RULES

Tee Ball and International League Bats

Two types of non-wooden bats may be used:

1. Bats with barrels not more than 2 1/4 inches in diameter with a BPF (bat performance standard) of 1.15 or less.
2. Bats that meet the “USA” Bat standard, as indicated by the USA seal on the bat. These are accepted and preferred. (Note: “USA” Bat standard bats can be 2-5/8 inches in diameter.)

National, American and Teen League Bats

All Recreational (“Rec”) bats must be wood, “USA” stamped or “BBCOR” stamped. Diameter of 2 5/8” or less. No “USSSA” bats.

Exception: Any bat that bears a green “Rec Approved” sticker affixed by the RPBL Equipment Coordinator.

Wooden Bats

In all leagues wooden bats may be used as long as the barrel diameter conforms to the same standards as aluminum bats. If a wooden bat is damaged, it must be replaced, not repaired.
